Print the **template** on card stock. Cut out and have the children color. Cut a slit in the watering can where indicated. Glue the bunny on a craft stick. Show the children how the bunny can pop in and out of the can.

FOOT SHAPED BUNNY

Materials:

White construction paper

Directions:

Trace around each child's foot on a piece of white construction paper. Let the children cut them out. Turn the foot so the narrow end is the head of the bunny. Decorate with rabbit ears, nose etc...
